Lesson 2

Warm-up (15 minutes): The card game "Anomia"

Review of the previous podcast episode (20 minutes):

- 1. Recall key details from the previous podcast episode and discuss them. (10 minutes):
 - What are some unique characteristics of the town Rockwall, Texas?
 - What is the daily life like for middle school students in this town?
 - How do they describe the school and its students?
 - How does the occasional fight at school reveal the social dynamics among teenagers today?

(The goal is to recall details, express your understanding, and form opinions based on what you heard.)

2. Discuss cultural differences (10 minutes).

- How do the community structures of Rockwall, Texas, and your hometown in Japan differ?
- How does the podcast's depiction of youth culture and interaction (through TikTok, Instagram, etc.) compare with your understanding of youth culture in Japan?
- The podcast describes the town of Rockwall as 'boring'. How would you describe your hometown, and how does it compare?
- Reflect on how the religious community, as described through the example of the Lake Point Baptist Church, contrasts with Japan.

(The goal is to focus on comprehension, recall, and discussion.)
