A detailed plan or route of a journey.

Example: "We planned our holiday itinerary carefully before we left."

budget

The amount of money available to  
spend.

Example: "Our budget for the whole weekend is ¥40,000."



reasonable

reasonable

Fair, sensible, and not too expensive.

Example: "The price for lunch at that cafe is quite reasonable."

scenic

scenic

Having beautiful natural views.

Example: "Let's take the scenic route along the coast."

admission fee

# admission fee

The price to enter a place (museum, park, etc.).

Example: "The admission fee for the museum is ¥1,500 per person."

# Useful Phrases for Planning

- **Making Suggestions:**
  - How about we...? / What if we go to...?
- **Negotiating:**
  - That's a good point, but... / I'm not sure if...
- **Compromising:**
  - Okay, let's compromise and...
