represent

represent

(verb) to be a sign or symbol of something.

Example: A smartphone **represents** how we communicate in 2025.

preserve

preserve

(verb) to keep something safe for a long time.

Example: We should **preserve** a photograph of our class.

significant

significant

(adjective) important or meaningful.

Example: Including a newspaper is **significant** because it shows the important news of our time.

Example: This menu gives a **snapshot**
of the food we eat.

It's essential to include...

Example: It's essential to include a face mask **because** it was a big part of our lives.
